- Long-term ecological/urban impacts
- Long-term social impacts
- Long-term cultural/economic Impacts

Three core questions by the Social Studies manager, joining the team in the autumn 2020

- **How can we communicate the 28 objectives (impacts) from the bidbook in a way that's clear and meaningful to people outside the project?**
- **How can we carry out monitoring and evaluation activities in a way that is both time- and cost-effective?**


Auditing, reorganising the impacts in 2021:

- **The cultural life in Tartu and Southern Estonia gains momentum**
- **Through participation in culture the well-being of the people of Tartu and Southern Estonia grows**

Kultuurikompass Capacity Building Programm




- > Key meeting places for cultural organisers in the region
- > 21 Kultuurikompass forums have been held (2019–2025), attracting 5500 visits
- > Based on the Southern Estonia Creative and Cultural Sector Survey
- > Survey 4 times conducted (2018, 2020, 2022, 2025)
- > Mapping of the needs and attitudes
- > 2025: 782 answers (started with 67 answers)
